WHEREAS, P.L. 2001, c.138 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances annually for snow removal; and

WHEREAS, the Township recently established a dedicated trust fund for the purpose of providing a stable source of funds for the costs of snow removal in years of unusually high snow occurrences; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with P.L. 2001, c. 138 and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-62, it is necessary for the Township Committee to authorize the transfer of unexpended balances to the snow removal reserve during the last two months of the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Township staff requests to transfer the available balance of \$25,000 from the 2022 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance - Salary & Wage appropriation to the Snow Removal Reserve Trust Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield in Burlington County, State of New Jersey, that the transfer of \$25,000 from the 2022 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance - Salary & Wage appropriation to the Snow Removal Trust Fund is hereby authorized in accordance with P.L. 2001, c. 138.
