ORDINANCE NO. 2023-7

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 66 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED
“ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES” MOST NOTABLY,
SECTION 66-10 ENTITLED “LOTTERIES, BINGO AND
RAFFLES”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 66, Alcoholic Beverages, Article I, Sale and Distribution, Section 66-10, Lotteries, Bingo and Raffles, of the Chesterfield Township Code be amended, revised and/or supplemented to now read as follows:

CHAPTER 66 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

ARTICLE I. Sale and Distribution.

§ 66-10 Lotteries, bingo and raffles.

No licensee shall allow, permit or suffer in or upon the licensed premises any lottery to be conducted or any ticket or participation right in any lottery to be sold or offered for sale; nor shall any licensee possess, have custody of or allow, permit or suffer any such ticket or participation right in or upon the licensed premises; provided, however, that this rule shall not apply to a licensee at a licensed retail distribution premises which shall be permitted to conduct sales of New Jersey Lottery after having obtained approval of the New Jersey Lottery Commission, all other agencies of the State of New Jersey having jurisdiction over such sales in a licensed retail distribution premises, nor shall this rule apply to bingo or raffles or tickets or participation rights therein being conducted pursuant to appropriate license under the Bingo Licensing Law (*N.J.S.A. 5:8-24*) or the Raffles Licensing Law (*N.J.S.A. 5:8-50*); but in any such instance of bingo at licensed premises, the licensee, during the period between the commencement of the first and the conclusion of the last game, shall not sell, serve or deliver or allow, permit or suffer the sale, service, delivery or consumption of any alcoholic beverage in any room or outdoor area where the bingo or any part thereof is being conducted.

*[bracketed language] denotes proposed stricken language and underlined language denotes new proposed language to the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

1. All ordinances or portions of ordinances which are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed as to their inconsistencies only.
2. If any provision or paragraph of this Ordinance shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the provisions or paragraphs so declared invalid shall be separable from the remainder or any portion thereof.
3. This Ordinance will take effect after publication and passage according to law.
