**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONVEYANCE OF PUBLIC WORKS  
EQUIPMENT IN EXCHANGE FOR PURCHASE OF, AND CREDIT AGAINST,  
NEW EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township has funds available through an ordinance to purchase a Carlton 1712 12” Capacity Disc Chipper, at a cost of Forty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Dollars and No Cents (\$47,940.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase will be from Cherry Valley Tractor Sales through the ESCNJ Co-op #65MCECCPS, Bid# 18/19-25; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township is in possession of the following equipment and estimated values:

1992 Bandit 200+ Chipper	\$ 2,500.00
Boss 10’ Power-Angle Snow Blade	\$ <u>800.00</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$ 3,300.00</b>

**WHEREAS**, the Township’s purchase of the Carlton 1712 12” Capacity Disc Chipper includes a credit of \$ 3,300.00 for the older equipment to be conveyed to Cherry Valley Tractor Sales as part of the transaction for the purchase of new equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(7) allows a governing body “by resolution [to] include the sale of personal property no longer needed for public use as part of the specifications to offset the price of new purchase”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township did determined that the older equipment was no longer needed for public use and in soliciting quotations for the new mowers, were offered a set-off against the price of the Carlton 1712 12” Capacity Disc Chipper.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(7), the Township hereby authorizes the Township Clerk and/or Chief Finance Officer to convey to Cherry Valley Tractor Sales, the equipment described above as consideration for the purchase of a Carlton 1712 12” Capacity Disc Chipper.
