**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$25,000 FROM THE  
2022 CURRENT BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR SNOW REMOVAL TO THE  
SNOW REMOVAL RESERVE TRUST FUND**

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2001, c.138 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances annually for snow removal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township recently established a dedicated trust fund for the purpose of providing a stable source of funds for the costs of snow removal in years of unusually high snow occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with P.L. 2001, c. 138 and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-62, it is necessary for the Township Committee to authorize the transfer of unexpended balances to the snow removal reserve during the last two months of the fiscal year, and

**WHEREAS**, the Township staff requests to transfer the available balance of \$25,000 from the 2022 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance - Salary & Wage appropriation to the Snow Removal Reserve Trust Fund;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield in Burlington County, State of New Jersey, that the transfer of \$25,000 from the 2022 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance - Salary & Wage appropriation to the Snow Removal Trust Fund is hereby authorized in accordance with P.L. 2001, c. 138.
