**RESOLUTION TO CANCEL TAXES DUE TO VETERAN EXEMPTION  
FOR 155 PRESERVATION BLVD KNOWN AS BLOCK 107.17 LOT 18**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

**WHEREAS**, Eric and Willmarie Rivera own the property located at 155 Preservation Boulevard known as Block 107.17 Lot 18 and recorded in deed dated February 4, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, Eric Rivera is a 100% disabled Veteran; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Rivera has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentary proofs required to the Tax Assessor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective September 11, 2022; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 107.17 Lot 18 effective September 11, 2022 and thereafter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel 2022 taxes in the amount of \$4,084.80 and 2023 preliminary taxes billed in the amount of \$6,684.05.
